Notice Of Race

Management:

The Bristol Yacht Club is the organizing authority. The series will be open to all mono-hulls owned by BYC members and, with the permission of the Race Committee, boats owned by non-members.

Schedule:

The Bristol Yacht Club Millard Series will consist of 12 races starting in Bristol Harbor on Wednesday evenings beginning June 2, 2010. Participation in the Fun Race (pursuit) will count as one race for season qualification or throw-out purposes but will not be otherwise considered in the season score calculations. All races are on Wednesdays. Note that August 4 is a MOHOSA race and not part of this series. It is listed for convenience in planning only.

Rules:

The series will be governed by *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012*, this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions. This is an Invitational event and advertising is restricted as follows: No advertising other than the sailmaker's, builder's or equipment manufacturer's marks as permitted in the ISAF Regulation 20.9.

PHRF Certificate:

No boat shall start a race or be scored until a 2010 PHRF-NB Rating Certificate has been received and recorded. To get a rating certificate, write to: PHRF-NB, PO Box 73, Bristol, RI 02809. Phone (401) 253-0207

Classes:

There will be separate classes for spinnaker, non-spinnaker and if there is enough interest, double handed boats. Double handed boats will race as a single class and can decide to use either their spinnaker or non-spinnaker rating for the season. Placement of yachts in the PHRF classes will be based on a yacht's PHRF-NB rating, length and other characteristics. The race committee will determine the class assignment of each yacht. A yacht, other than the double handers, may change to or from a spinnaker class once during the season. A yacht doing so will lose all points gained in their original class.

The race committee reserves the right to add or delete one-design classes depending on the number of potential entrants in each class.

Trophies:

Daily trophies and seasonal trophies will be awarded to each class. There will also be a trophy for the boat with the lowest scoring average in all regular classes that average five or more competitors per race. Separate trophies will also be awarded on a daily basis for One-Design classes.

Registration:

Entry fee is \$50.00 for members of Bristol Yacht Club; those who are also members of US Sailing receive a \$5.00 discount. The entry fee for competitors who are not members of Bristol Yacht Club is \$150.00 for the first year then \$300.00 for each subsequent year. Deadline to receive registration is May 19, 2010. Entries received after that date will require a \$25.00 late fee.
