Since 1904, the Bristol Yacht Club has been providing this great chance to race offshore in the Sid Clark Overnight Race. The BYC makes it fun with moorings in the harbor, showers at the clubhouse, prizes and an awards party.

The race will start on Saturday afternoon. There will be a long course of 91 miles out to Montauk Point and a shorter course to Block Island if the winds are exceptionally light or heavy.

The great traditions remain: Start right in Bristol Harbor. Choose spinnaker or cruising canvas, full crew or double-handed. Any way you do it, this race will be a highlight of your summer.
