

DOUBLE DUTCH REGATTA 2018 SI, Courses & Social schedule



Welcome Double Dutch Regatta participants.

Quick Time guide:

- Skippers meeting: 10:00 hrs. July 28th Bristol Yacht Club
- Race Start Bristol Harbor: 11:55 hrs. July 28th (start times are assigned, see SI below)
- Beach Party gathering: 16:00 hrs. July 28th Dutch harbor boat yard landing
- Race Start Dutch Harbor: 9:55 hrs. July 29th (start times are assigned, see SI below)
- Barbecue Bristol Yacht Club: 16:00 hrs.

SI (Sailing instructions):

Rules: US Sailing Rules of Racing (*RRS*) 2017 – 2020 as amended and these instructions.

Entries: Boats will register by completing online registration with Bristol Yacht Club on Sign up genius (<https://www.signupgenius.com/go/60b0944adae2da1ff2-double>) no later than 16:00 on 25 July. For questions, contact Curt Mahlstedt at:

The Start: Races will be started by using rule *RRS* 26 with the warning signal made 5 minutes before the first starting signal only. All subsequent starts will have a starting signal at the time that any boats will start per the scratch sheet.

The Bristol Harbor Start and Finish Line will be south of the Bristol harbor mooring field, off State Street dock between an orange, inflatable buoy and a staff displaying an orange or white flag on the Race Committee signal boat.

The Dutch Harbor Start and Finish Line will be north of Fox Hill between Government Buoy N “2” and a staff displaying an orange or white flag on the Race Committee signal boat.

Each boat shall check in with the Race Committee Boat on the starting line before the race providing the following information – sail number, number of people on board.

Starting Sequence: A Scratch Sheet listing all competitors and starting times will be made available prior to the race at the Bristol YC or emailed to the address on the applications. Timing will be based on GPS time.

First gun (start):

- The scheduled time of the warning signal for Race 1 on July 28 to Dutch Harbor is 11:55 am.
- The scheduled time of the warning signal for Race 2 (return to Bristol) on July 29 is 9:55 am.

Courses:

See Attachment A (below) for the 3 possible race courses provided for each race day. The Race Committee Boat will display the course selected for each race prior to the starts.

Special Instructions: Stay South of C"3", Usher's Cove and north of Castle Island while exiting and entering Bristol Harbor.

Sails: Spinnakers are not allowed. Headsail changes are allowed. Only a single headsail, fully hanked to the headstay is allowed except during rapid change of headsail.

Whisker Pole: J+3" max or class standard allowed.

Protests: Yacht being protested must be notified at earliest convenient moment. The Race Committee must be notified after crossing finish line. Protest will be heard immediately following the race.

Time Limits: The time limit for all boats to complete the course is 6 hours from the first start.

Cancellations and Postponements: Abandonment Signals will be in accordance with *RRS* Race Signals. A postponement will be signaled by hoisting the Answering Pennant (AP) with two sound signals. After a postponement has been made, the Answering Pennant will be lowered with one sound signal followed one minute later by the Warning Signal. The Race Committee may precede the lowering of the Answering Pennant by a flurry of sounds to call attention to it. All starts will proceed per the original starting sequence, plus the added amount of time added to the first start.

The abandonment of all races will be signaled by hoisting flags N over A with 3 sound signals.

Scoring: Because this is a staggered start event, there is no handicap taken at the finish. The first boat to cross the finish line within the time limit is the winner, the second boat to cross the line will be scored as second, etc.

Safety Regulations: A boat shall Check-In with the Race Committee prior to racing by identifying herself by sail number and reporting the number of Crew aboard. It is each boat's responsibility to assure acknowledgement from the race committee. A boat shall Check-Out with the race committee by finishing the race, or, if retiring, to do so as soon as possible by

radio on VHF Channel 71, or by calling Mark Rotsky at 508-245-1192. A yacht that has withdrawn must not cross the finish line.

Radio Communication: VHF Channel 71 will be used for any announcements by the race committee and for communication with competitors. The race committee will make efforts to broadcast courtesy racing information such as weather, courses, starting sequence, starting violations, time limits, etc. Failure to do so will not be grounds for redress.

Prizes: Prizes will be awarded at the post race BBQ at Bristol YC after racing on Sunday.

Trash Disposal: Boats shall not put trash in the water.

Disclaimer of Liability: Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See *RRS* rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

Insurance: Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance.
