## A Cheat-Sheet on The Gaspee Days Cruise:



- Parking is limited at the club, and street parking "bleeds" into the surrounding neighborhood. The "early bird gets the worm", if you plan to drive to the RIYC.
- Plan on leaving by 4 pm (at the latest) on Friday, 6/7/24 if motoring or sailing to the RIYC.
- Hailing RIYC on VHF channel 78.
- RIYC Launch hours: Friday Noon, running until all guest boaters are back "home" on their boats. Saturday – Starting at 7:45 am, then same as above for Sat. night. Sunday – Starting at 7:45 am.
- Note: RIYC's dinghy dock area is small, and very limited.
- Phone the RIYC: 401-941-0220, ext. 6 for the dock house.
- RIYC's Cocktail Party for BYC, Friday, 6/7/24 6 pm, & Friday Night Dinner, 7 pm. Saturday morning RIYC provided coffee & donuts, starting at 8:30 am. Saturday Cookout is 1:00 pm to 7:00 pm; & Sunday's Breakfast Buffet is 8:30 to 11:00 am are both a-la-carte. You may want to bring some cash (\$).
- BYC group Saturday Dinner is on-your-own. Most of the area restaurants are on Narragansett Blvd. I have provided a list, for your reference.
- The Gaspee Parade is on Narragansett Parkway, in Pawtuxet Village, RI, and it starts at 10 am.
- FYI 30 to 34 Narragansett Blvd. is a good spot to meet for the parade, as Bob McLaughlin's sister lives there, and has historically been a very gracious host to the BYC group.
- Things to remember to bring: Folding chairs, 4<sup>th</sup> of July clothing and regalia, noise makers, etc., comfortable walking shoes, sunscreen, some water bottles, cash (see above), and a desire to have some fun!
